ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Each team will present on an assigned movie/video/topic. All members of the team must help in preparing slides for the presentation. Team leaders will delegate specific slides to their members.

- Each team is responsible for selecting speakers for the presentation.
- The presentation duration for each team is 10 minutes with 5 minutes for questions. Typically a ten minute oral presentation will require 12-15 slides excluding title slide.

Your presentation must include the following:

- a) Title slide with team member names
- b) Setting of the event; Brief information about the country/state/city etc; Include both social, economical and environmental information
- c) Contaminant characteristics: Chemistry and health impacts
- d) Conclusion: What is the moral/ethical/social value of the assigned video/movie/event? Did it impact legislation/environmental regulations etc.
- e) Please address social, gender, racial biases/discrimination issues.
